It's possible. But it could be that you are just getting older. The Captain, as well as others in the Club, have occasionally been called an Old Fogey (I'm looking at you Don Olson!). FOGY is actually an old nautical term for longevity pay. The extra money paid to the sailors with seniority was logged in the paymasters diary as F.O.G.Y. – which is an abbreviation of the phrase: For On-going Good Years. Those which seemed steadfast in their traditions, notions or beliefs were dismissed by the young sailors by assertion that they were an "old fogey."

Also, some of our members have been called a Yankee. It can be a derogatory term when spoken with a thick southern accent. This name can evoke pride or negative connotations depending who is speaking it, and which teams are in the World Series. As you've guessed, the term is nautical in origin and was given to Americans by the Dutch. Early American sea captains were known, but not revered, for their ability to drive a hard bargain. Dutchmen, who were also regarded at the time as extremely frugal (the expression "go dutch" means everybody pays their own way), jokingly referred to these hard negotiating Americans as "Yankers" and the nom de plume persists to this day worldwide.
